PASTOR'S CORNER

Architect Jim Van Compernelle, Project Manager Moshir Kellada, Our Archdiocesan Project Manager Williamson Sy, and I presented our project status for the improvements of the land, expanded parking, and the construction of the daily Mass Chapel last Monday to the Archdiocesan Building Commission. Parishioners Bob Fenbers, Gabe Garcia, Vic Pesce and Ramon Ramirez accompanied me to the meeting. The ABC members voted unanimously to grant us permission to proceed with design development. The official letter should arrive in a couple weeks. Finally we are at the roll up the sleeves it's about to happen phase! I am so excited. Please continue to support the regular collection and the building project capital campaign to the best of your ability.

Several of you have expressed interest in working on the actual construction. Please watch the Sunday Bulletin as I will post bid information there as soon as I know it. Moshir Kellada will be the one who seeks those and does the actual process. **Please don't depend on my memory to give Moshir your business card.** Do know, however, that both Jim and Moshir know that we want to use as many local companies as possible.

Please continue to pray for the Synod on the Family in Rome. There are two more weeks of meetings to go. Please take all you read and hear in the news with a grain of salt. There is often a lot of fuss and feathers made over a phrase or two taken out of context. The Synod is similar to a General Chapter in a religious Congregation. As discussions unfold, it is common for members to change their opinion. This is not being wishy-washy, but rather listening with humility and an obedient ear. **The Holy Spirit will not allow the Holy Father and the bishops around him to lead the Church away from salvation—“the gates of hell will not prevail against her,”** said Jesus. But human opinion, timidity and agendas can and too often do get in the way of the Holy Spirit and the surprises God has in store for the Church, a rich deposit of faith and of life, but not a museum. The Tradition must be incarnated in every age, but it cannot be abandoned for “development.” Wisdom, counsel and fortitude are needed from the Holy Spirit in abundance!

October is Rosary Month

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the *Apostles' Creed*, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The *Our Father*, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the *Hail Mary* is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. St. Pius V officially added the second part of the *Hail Mary*. The Mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and—added by Pope John Paul II in 2002—the Luminous.

The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead one into restful and contemplative prayer related to each Mystery. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Christ's spirit dwells. The Rosary can be said privately or with a group.
